Ceremony of the handing over of the Rosaries

7th October 2023

The Rosary is the prayer that Padre Pio gave his Prayer Groups as a sign of recognition. The ceremony of the Rosary handout was established to unite us with Mary so that the Church can always enjoy her protection. On the 7th of October (or another day agreed with their Spiritual Assistant) the Group meets for a catechesis and for the Rosary ceremony.

The rosaries are blessed and the commitment to the recitation of the Rosary is renewed. When this rite is celebrated at the end of Mass, the Celebrant will adapt it accordingly.

Celebrant: Brothers and sisters, the liturgy of the Church has its centre in the Eucharist and - during the day - is marked by the Liturgy of the Hours. Padre Pio suggested the holy rosary to his spiritual children to meditate on the Word of God guided by the Blessed Virgin Mary. Today we want to commit ourselves together and pray often the holy rosary, possibly daily, to live our journey together as a Padre Pio Prayer Group.

From the Gosple according to Luke (8, 5-15)

"A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path; it was trampled on, and the birds ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, and when it came up, the plants withered because they had no moisture. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up with it and choked the plants. Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up and yielded a crop, a hundred times more than was sown."

When he said this, he called out, "Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear."

His disciples asked him what this parable meant. He said, "The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of God has been given to you, but to others I speak in parables, so that, 'though seeing, they may not see; though hearing, they may not understand.'

"This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is the word of God. Those along the path are the ones who hear, and then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved. Those on the rocky ground are the ones who receive the word with joy when they hear it, but they have no root. They believe for a while, but in the time of testing they fall away. The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life's worries, riches and pleasures, and they do not mature. But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop."

What you must do when Jesus in His goodness puts you to the test is to show your great promptness in the observance of your duties at all times, without neglecting any of the practices which you perform in times of consolation and prosperity. I encourage you not to mind the lack of all pleasurable feelings, since they are merely accidental and can often be quite dangerous to the soul. True and substantial devotion consists in serving God without any tangible consolation. This means serving and loving God for His own sake.

Until the soul has reached the acquisition of this substantial devotion, it is in a precarious state and must proceed with great caution and discretion.

In this state, you will find helpful to read holy books. It is my wish to see you read such books at all times, for such reading will provide you with excellent food for your souls, as well as lead you along the path towards perfection. This is by no means inferior to what we obtain through prayer and meditation. While in prayer and meditation we are the ones speaking to the Lord, in holy books it is indeed the Lord who is speaking to us. I encourage you to treasure those holy readings, and you will soon be aware of a spiritual renewal within you.
